## Historical Mapping of the Coastlines, Rivers, Rails, Roads and Watersheds for Water Supply in Washington

Mr. Sleight has served in senior positions involving civil and hydraulic engineering and reviewed private development activity over the past 23+ years at Snohomish County. He has approved or designed over 600 miles of roads in Snohomish County. He has taught low impact development concepts and engineering courses at both Edmonds CC and Shoreline CC, and teaches the annual ethics course to the Land Surveyors in Training (LSIT) for the LSAW PLS Refresher Course. An early member of WSS-ACSM (first attended in 1974 as a Survey Student at the UW), he became a member upon graduation in 1975. He was an officer for the organization for 10 years and chair of the organization when NAD 83 legislation was passed and signed into law. He is presently on the Board of Directors.

**He will be including some Spanish maps of the Coast circa 1775 and maps by David Thompson - tracking down the source of the Columbia River as well as early rail maps.**
